Visit 21 Acres and take an official tour of the Farm. Open to the public, these free **Farm Tours** at will be held on the first Saturday of the month at 11:00 a.m. beginning Saturday, June 7 through Saturday, October 4, 2008. Walk the trails, meander through the gardens and wildlife corridor and see what's currently growing on the Farm. *(Complete schedule below.)*

Learn about permaculture, sustainable agricultural and conservation systems. Rain or shine and bring a folding chair if you want to relax and sit for a spell.

21 Acres, located at 13701 NE 171st Street, just south of Woodinville, is a non-profit organization with the mission to cultivate, demonstrate and advance systems that support sustainable agriculture. Along with the Community Garden, the land supports a commercial farm growing food for families, markets, schools and hunger relief. The new agricultural building, scheduled to break ground in summer, 2008, is a cutting edge "green-built" facility that will feature a year-round farmers market, community kitchen and space for its popular classes on urban farming techniques and sustainability – providing vital infrastructure and education to help keep small farms in business.
